

Tournament Rules

Players **MUST** be ready to start at allocated time—Have Great Fun!

Matches are grouped into two lots in order to keep numbers down. The first two scheduled times must be at the courts at 6:30pm. The next two scheduled times need to be at the courts before 7:30pm.

Each match consists of three Point-a-Rally (PAR) games, The winner is the first player to reach 22 points. The 1st & 2nd games will attract one Progress Point (PP) each, the 3rd game is worth two PPs.

If a player is unable to play at the scheduled time, they must inform Gloria & also arrange a Pre or Post Play Match with their opponent, to be played by the last night of the season. The opponent must still be present at the original scheduled time in order to claim the forfeit & fulfil referring duties.

If a forfeit is absolutely unavoidable you must contact Gloria who will arrange an alternate match for your Opponent who will receive a 66-0 win on the night.

DECIDING EVENT WINNER—There will be a Winner, Runner-up & Third place prize in each Event.

An undefeated player shall be the Winner of the Event. If there is no undefeated player, then the player with the most PPs shall be the winner of the Event.

If two or more players are equal on PPs then the player with most game points shall be the Winner. This method shall also be used to determine the Runner-Up & Third place getters.
