HBS Thursday Night Squash Comp Guidelines 2024 - Season 1

- 1. All competition players must be a member of Hervey Bay Squash Club Inc.
- 2. Players must be a member of Health Club Hervey Bay, or pay for court fees on the night.
- 3. Official Start time is 6:30pm, and everyone should try to be present for team support
 - a. If you wish to take advantage of the 6:00pm early start time for your teams court then you are required to pre-arrange this with your opponent & also your team captain and the Health Club.
- 4. Order of play is determined by the arrival time of matching opponents unless otherwise organised.
- 5. Supper is managed on a rotational basis. Check the 'Matches with dates & Supper Team' for your team's turn. Supper teams will assist with bar service on the night and clean up afterwards.
- 6. If you are unable to play here are your options:
 - a. Arrange a pre-play with your opponent. Ensure you inform the Convenor of your pre-play. Blank Score sheets are pinned to the notice board next to the Bar.
 - b. Call on a player from the Reserves List on your line or lower with a similar ranking. Please message the Convenor and your team captain after organising a Reserve so that duplication of finding a reserve can be avoided. (Note: Reserves can only play finals if they have played 3 or more times in the season and are similar in standard to the player replaced)
 - c. If the above two fail, ask a team mate from a lower line to play for you, as well as their match.
 - d. Post-plays are **not** permitted.
 - e. Ensure your Team Captain is notified of your inability to play.
 - f. You will not receive match points won by the reserve player.
- 7. All team members must mark and referee matches on a regular basis.
- 8. Matches are best of 5 games scoring to 9 points (or 10 if long game is called at 8-ALL) with handouts.
- 9. <u>Individual</u> Progress points (PPs) are awarded as follows:-3/0 = 5 points, 3/1 = 4 points, 3/2 = 3 points, 2/3 = 2 points, 1/3 = 1 points, 0/3 = 0 points.
- 10. <u>Weekly Team Points</u> equals the number of winning rubbers. Winning team is decided on rubbers (if even), on games (if even), on points . The winning team also gets two bonus points. (1 point each for a tie).
- 11. <u>End of Season</u> Team Positions for Semis & Finals are decided as; 1st an Undefeated team, followed by teams with the most TPs. If TPs are equal, then decided by matches won, then by games, then by Points.
- 12. <u>Line winners</u> are only calculated from matches played during the season. (Not Finals)
- 13. When a player receives a forfeit, they will receive 5 points, their team will receive 1 point for that match, and the player, who forfeits, will receive 0 points.
- 14. In the case of a mutual forfeit, neither team will receive any points for that match.
- 15. The Major Semi-Finals will be $1 ext{ v } 4$, and $2 ext{ v } 3$, as determined at the end of the season. The winners will play in the **Grand Final**. The Plate Semi-Finals will be $5 ext{ v } 8$, and $6 ext{ v } 7$. The Plate Grand Final will be between the Plate Semi Final winners. All eight teams will play on Grand Final night.
- 16. All **Grand Final** matches must be played on the night (No pre-plays, including earlier in the day)
