

HERVEY BAY SQUASH INC.
2026 TUESDAY DAYTIME COMPETITION – Season 1

Play commences at 8:30 am: Ensure enough team members are present to mark & referee first matches on, otherwise the opposing team may claim a FORFEIT. You are required to inform your Captain & Opponent if you will be late.

Fees: From 1 January 2026 the HBS membership will be changing from a calendar year membership (i.e. Jan – Dec) to a financial year membership (i.e. Jul – Jun). Therefore the Jan-Jun 2026 six-month Squash Membership is \$20 no matter how many Competitions you play. Further information will be forthcoming from the HBS Committee on membership for the financial year 2026-2027 in due course. Membership of Mako's Health Club is required to use the courts, **and** is to be paid at the front counter.

Morning Tea Duty: The rostered team members are required to;

1. Provide a plate of food to share with all players. Discuss with your team to ensure there will be a selection of sweet, savoury and fruit.
2. Clean up and pack away cups, utensils etc. and take home the tea towels to wash.

Social Squash: On Friday mornings from 9:00 am there is a social hit and all players, both Comp and Social are welcome to join. Mako's Health Club members can use the courts anytime included in the Membership.

Notice Board: The Draw sheet, Run sheet, Teams & Individuals Points Tables, etc. are updated on the web weekly and are also placed on notice board located next to the Bar upstairs.

Scoring: All team members must mark & referee on a regular basis. Other players are always willing to assist you to learn how, if you are not sure or need support.

Matches are played as Best-of-Five, Point-a-Rally (PAR) to 15 points (or 17 if long game is called at 14-ALL). Individual Progress Points (PPs) are calculated as follows:

Weekly Team points are calculated by adding the individual team member's PPs with the winning team collecting an additional two PPs. If there is a tie, the two bonus PPs are shared.

Balls: are to be returned to the box upstairs by the last players on court.

Absences:

1. If you know you will be away for any of the weeks during the Season, you are welcome to pre-play your match. You will need to organize this directly with your opponent, or;
2. If there is a Bye Team in the current draw, and if you can't pre-play, in the first instance, please ask the player on your Playing Line from the Bye Team to fill-in for you, or
3. If that player is unavailable, then refer to the Reserve List to assist in seeking a reserve of similar grading level as you, or
4. Ask the player in your team on the Line below you to play up for you.

Insurance: We have Public Liability Insurance only, no Player Insurance. **Players are reminded that they play at their own risk.**
